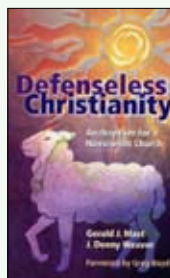

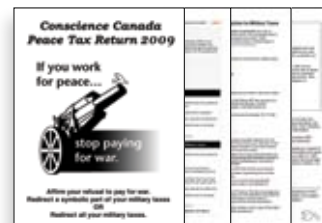
Power and Practices: Engaging the Work of John Howard Yoder

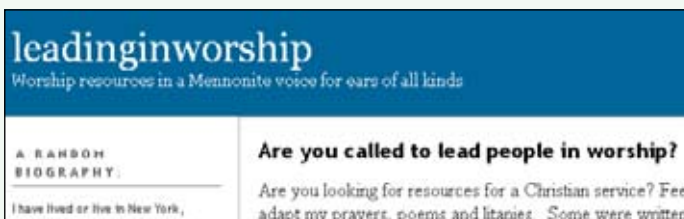

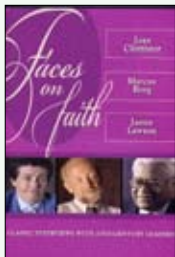
Amazing Grace

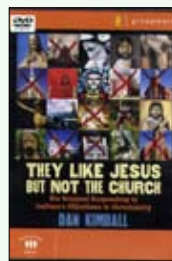
Shaping Holy Lives: Benedictine Spirituality in the Contemporary World

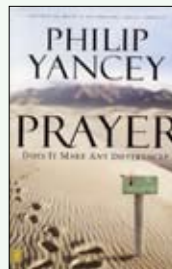
Religion & Violence: Untangling the Roots of Conflict, an interfaith dialogue
