Minister:

(invites extended family to lay hands on the parents and child(ren) as she/he offers his blessing):

Minister:

(wraps child in the blanket, offering this blessing as she/he lays hands on the child's head)

Hymn: 620 (HWB) Child of blessing, child of promise

(during the song the minister walks amidst the congregation with the child, giving people permission to touch and bless.)

Minister:

As a symbol of the congregation's partnership with this family in nurturing her/his relationship with God, we present you with this "Faith Chest" In this chest are some items for the journey of faith that is beginning now in this community. These are reminders that this child, that came from God, belongs to God and has been entrusted to *our* care.

Blessing (unison):
