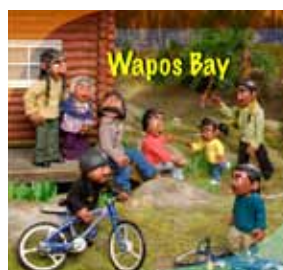

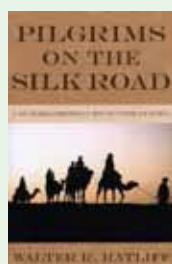
An account of the many challenges of caring for an elderly loved one, including spiritual crisis, not the least of which included fear of one's own suffering and death.

Guides readers through the minefield of hospital visits and offers a theology of visitation that can guide both professionals and laity in their ministry.



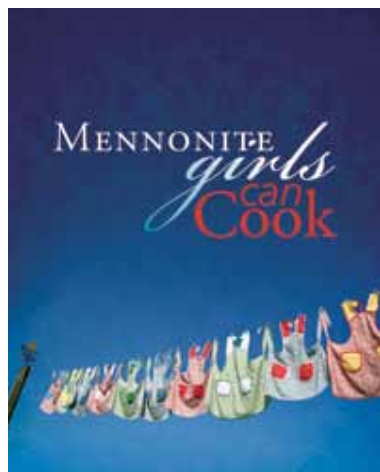
All That Matters: Collected Scripts from Radio 4's 'Thought For the Day,' volume 2

Offers practical advice on how to govern a non-profit organization from a spiritual vantage point.



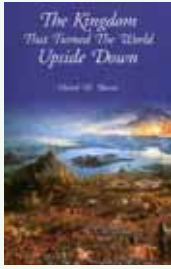

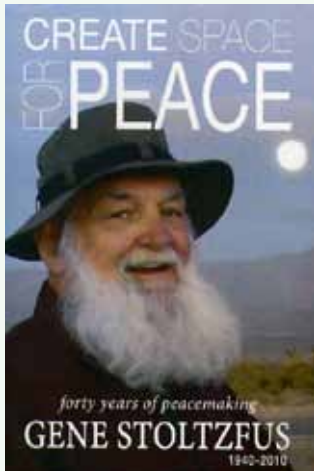

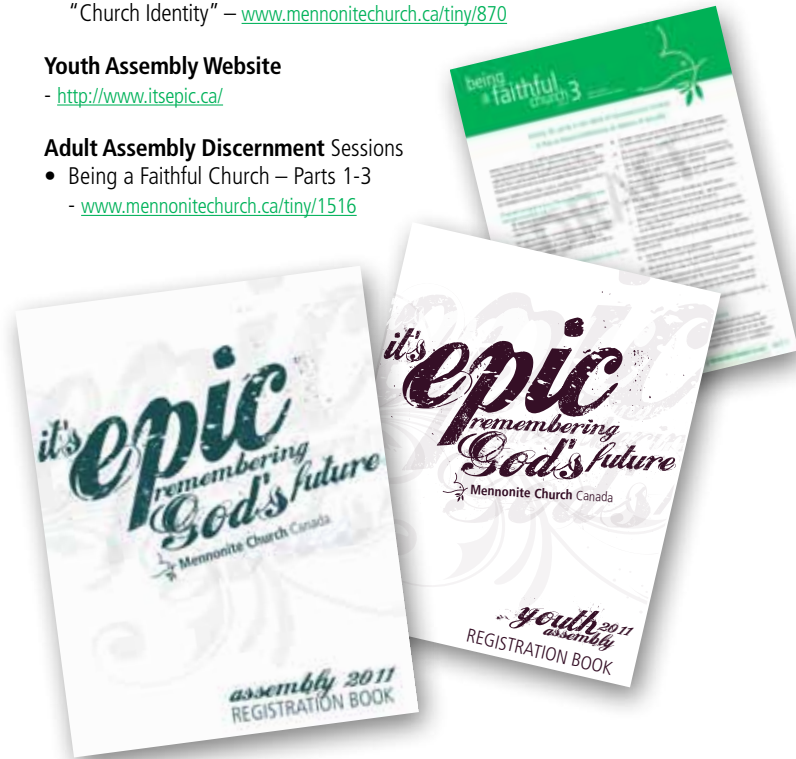
