This interactive workshop will explore creativity as a tool for working against oppression. Through historical, global and personal case studies, participants will come to understand peace-building as an art that often calls for a creative approach. From engaging theatre and facilitated discussion to role-playing scenarios and interactive simulation games, participants will harness their own creative potential for a more peaceable world.

Goals & Outcomes

- explore the idea of peace-building as an art -form that requires a creative approach
- gain awareness of the work of various global artists/activists who use their passions for social justice
- be given the opportunity to practice non-violent responses to conflict, as well as act out responses through forum theatre
