John 15:26-27, Acts 2:1-4, Acts 4:33, 1 Corinthians 12:4-6, 1 Peter 2:9, Ephesians 1:14-16

Reader 1: Jesus said: When the Advocate comes,
whom I will send from the Father,
the Advocate will testify on my behalf.
You also are to testify
because you have been with me from the beginning.

Reader 2: When the day of Pentecost had come, all of them were filled with the Holy Spirit

Reader 3: and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability.

ALL: With great power the apostles gave their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all.

Reader 1: Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; Reader 2: and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord;

Reader 3: and there are varieties of activities,

ALL: but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone.

Reader 1: You are a chosen race, a royal priesthood,

Reader 2: a holy nation,

Reader 3: God's own people,

ALL: in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of the One who called you out of darkness into marvelous light.

Reader 1: In Christ you also, when you had heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation,

Reader 2: and had believed in him,

Reader 3: were marked with the seal of the promised Holy Spirit;

ALL: This is the pledge of our inheritance toward redemption as God's own people, to the praise of God's glory.
