Did the delegates understand the purpose of the actions list, and why the motion was required? How did we expect the delegates to engage? The main discussion was around the policy "On Speaking Publicly and On Individual Acts of Conscientious Civil Disobedience".

29 30 31 32	CONSENSUS: Review the Civil Disobedience Policy draft at each Regional Church board with discussion/feedback forwarded to Gerald and Arli. Gerald and Arli will then review the Policy with the discussions that were had among those at the Regional level. They will have an updated draft for review by JC at the January 2020 meeting.

d) Feedback from Participants

ACTION: MC Canada Communications Officer will collect all feedback from the participants using an on-line survey. Summary to be made available to JC.

- e) Feedback on LGBTQ+, Friends, Family event.
 - i) It was noted that some attending still see a need for reconciliation between the church and the LGBTQ community within the church. A discussion was held on how to bring about this reconciliation, and on how to work more closely with / inclusively with those in the LGBTQ+ community.

f) Gathering Feedback

- i) Some comments were noted by Joint Council members:
 - (1) Concern about the carbon footprint of these gatherings in general.
 - (2) Concern about the financial cost of the Gathering
 - (3) Desire for more conversation and engagement
 - (4) Appreciation for flexibility on Gathering meeting in three years, giving space for the MWC. Others who expressed the opposite feeling because not many Canadians would be attending MWC in 2021 in Indonesia.
 - (5) Comments about a positive spirit at the Gathering.
 - (6) Logistics and communication could have been clearer.

ACTION: Put together a checklist and guide for all of the details needed for next Gathering planning. Coordinate the tasks and reflection of the work of Communications Officer, Event Planner, and others directly involved planning the Gathering. Define the roles/responsibilities of the Event Planner and Communications Officer.

- (7) 300 registrants; 400 people on Sunday.
- **(8)** Sunday morning was way too long for people who are just coming for the worship. Need some free time around so people from local congregations have opportunity to connect with others from across country.
- (9) Keynote speaker was understandable and practical.

4) Continuation Costs for Friedenhaus Ludwigshafen Partner Program.

CONSENSUS: That we use funds from the internally restricted church building fund (0-000-2601) to pay for a two year commitment to our partner program Friedenhaus Ludwigshafen to the amount of \$22,000 for FYE2020 and \$11,000 for FYE2021.
