Worship Service Outline

Welcome

Thank you for coming to join together in prayer. Jesus says, Where 2 or 3 are gathered in my name, I am there among them (Matthew 18:20). We are invited to bring our burdens to God. We will begin with a reminder of God's Sovereignty from the Psalms and Isaiah. Then we will spend time lamenting using Lamentations and Psalms. We will voice our prayers and end again with a reminder of God's Sovereignty.

Note: Scripture passages may be read by a single leader or be divided into multiple readers with or without congregational response.
