A study guide has been prepared for the Gathering to help congregations learn and discern together around evangelism and witness. It follows the six sessions of the study guide, setting them up as a six-week sermon series. The goal is to encourage pastors, lay preachers, and worship committees who may wish to engage with the theme of MC Canada Gathering 2022 through sermon rather than, or alongside, study sessions. Users of this material are encouraged to read through the study guide for more background to the sessions and topics.</p> <p>Every congregation, and every preacher, approaches preaching differently. Preachers and worship committees are encouraged to use this material as they deem best for their unique situation. You might wish to focus on only one of the suggested Scripture passages for a sermon; you might wish to weave more than one into the sermon. You might find the questions and illustrations and songs fit exactly how you would like to shape a sermon or worship service; you might find that one week's materials works well for you, but another does not. You might want to compress this into fewer weeks, focusing on certain texts and topics or combining two weeks into one.
