People:	From a triumphant Palm Sunday to a dark, betrayed Friday, we have
	journeyed to Easter. Wiser now, we know that joy and sorrow, life and
	death are bound together. Passing through sorrow, through death, to life
	and joy, we arrive at Easter.
Leader:	The risen Jesus still bore the marks of the nails. Life knows death, joy knows
	sorrow. Yet it is life which triumphs over all, and love which conquers all fear.

	had lost its power.
Leader:	We have survived the deaths, the sorrows, the pains. We receive new life.
All:	Rejoice! Life bursts through death. God is with us. Alleluia!
