## God with Us...While we Rest

## based on Matthew 11:28; John 10:10; Colossians 3:17

using various Biblical Translations

Voice 1: Stop and listen to the Word: Come to me, all you who are weary and carry heavy burdens.

Voice 2: That's me all right – tired, worn out, carrying the weight of the world on my shoulders.

Sometimes I don't know if I can keep on holding everything together. I'm just so tired.

Voice 1: Come to me, all you whose load is heavy, who labor and are burdened, who are over-burdened... and I will give you rest.

Voice 2: Rest – give me a break. I don't have time for rest. Or sleep, breaks, or naps. They just don't fit into my life. Rest is a bit of a pipe dream, I think.

Voice 1: Let me try it another way?
Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out - even on religion?
Come to me.
Get away with me and you'll recover your life.

Voice 2: Recover my life?
I never knew I lost my life – but I guess I just don't know anymore who I am, or who is God.
There are so many distractions.
It's too scary to get in touch with yourself, to face who you are. I don't want to take away the distractions and be fully honest.

Voice 1: Get away with me and you'll recover your life. I'll show you how to take a real rest.

Voice 2: A real rest?
Ahh. That's too good to be true.

Voice 1: I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly, in all its fullness.

Voice 2: Fullness I know – My life is full with so many things, with work and activity, clubs and sports, shopping and computers and family and more. I'm abundantly busy!

Voice 1: I came that they may have life, and have it more abundantly.

## Voice 2: You mean abundance doesn't equal busyness?

- Voice 1: I came so they can have real and eternal life, more and better life than they ever dreamed.
- Voice 2: I dream about a life filled with joy and contentment, and a life with time – for relationships, God – real, quality time. Is that what abundance is all about?
- Voice 1: And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
- **Voice 2: This is about everything you do?**
- Voice 1: Let every word and action, every detail in your lives, be done in the name of the Master, Jesus, thanking God every step of the way.
- Voice 2: Rest? Abundance? Fullness? Everything? Thanksgiving? Hmm... Lord, let me stop and listen.
