Reader 3: We stand in awe, O God, of the wondrous skills here applied: the encompassing eye of the planner, the tempered patience of crafter and engineer; the calloused hands of builders who labour for the common good.

People: O God, let no talent be overlooked in the building of your reign and let us never fail to acknowledge each offering made to your church.

Reader 4: We call to you O God, to cast your spirit among us this day. Let us be builders of a holy temple: a place where people may find peace in the face of turmoil, yet not a place where complacency finds a home. Let us be servants and visionaries both, planters and harvesters each, stewards of a living treasure.

People: O God, make the seeds we plant this day call forth a bounteous crop and let the fruit of that crop be our lives dedicated to you now and ever more. Amen.
