From Grateful to Generous: Stewardship Sermons by John H. Neufeld.



Small Group Studies




Safe Church Policies



Feminist Theology



Women and Christianity, 3 volumes by Mary T. Malone. The history of Christianity reveals a great ambivalence towards women. On the one hand, women have been included, graced, called, inspired, and canonized by Christianity throughout the centuries. On the other hand, women have not always felt appreciated within the Christian

tradition and have indeed often been excluded and even oppressed. This series brings to light both the persistent courage and the innovative quality of women's lives.



Christian Feminism: Sojourners on the Issues. Jesus radically valued women as disciples throughout his ministry. In doing so, he challenged cultural assumptions. The stories of women's faith, failings, and heroism are too often undervalued in Christian tradition-but the contributions and creativity of women of faith are vital for both the church and the world.

Combines Bible study, social analysis, history, and personal testimonies to spark discussion.
