

Part one of this two-part DVD, "Manna from Heaven" provides a glimpse into the process of providing canned food to hungry people around the world. In "Trees of Hope" hear the stories of people in Burundi who are using canned meat in their communities to stop hunger.



Worship Feast: Lent and Easter CD-ROM, Abingdon Press, 2007. Takes youth groups from Shrove Tuesday to Easter Sunrise with creative, experiential worship outlines. Also includes five original Lent-themed worship songs on a CD-Rom and printed lyrics with chords.



This book came about through interviews with ministers and others who have shared the grace of God in the most intense of circumstances, specifically in major Australian disasters. It explores the realities of such ministry and its effect on ministry agents and explores the issues of post-traumatic stress and recovery.



Jim's Grandiose Big Bible Picture Book by James Paterson, Bastian Books, 2007. Famous stories of the Bible - Garden of Eden, Noah's Ark, Joseph and his coat of many colours, the three Wise Men, and Joseph and Mary's flight into Egypt - are artistically depicted as you've never seen them before. 
