



Four Feet, Two Sandals, by Karen Lynn Williams and Khadra Mohammed; illustrated by Doug Chayka, Wm. B. Eerdman's, 2007.

When relief workers bring used clothing to the refugee camp, everyone scrambles to grab whatever they can. Ten-year-old Lina is thrilled when she finds a sandal that fits her foot perfectly, until she sees that another girl has the matching shoe. But soon Lina and Feroza meet and decide that it is better to share the sandals than for each to wear only one.

This book portrays the strength, courage, and hope of refugees around the world, whose daily existence is marked by uncertainty and fear.



Beyond Me: Grounding Youth Ministry in God's Story, by Wendell Loewen, Faith and Life Resources, 2008. This resource grounds youth ministry in God's reign, which contrasts with the consumerism and alienation of today's adolescent story. At the heart of this "contrast culture" are a relationship with a God who

is lovingly involved in our world; a community where youth and adults connect meaningfully and follow Christ together; a discipleship that includes compassionate service; and a conviction that God's future has invaded the present.




Sing the Story 2 CD, Herald Press, 2008. The music featured here is based on the book, Sing the Story, published in 2007. The music embraces the heart of our worship and devotion: Jesus Christ. The selections especially focus

on the seasons of the church year from Advent to Pentecost, telling the story of Jesus.



**The Family Song** by June Hoober Piefer, Herald Press, 2008. Every day, the friendly Stranowsky family sings their favourite song to help them remember all of God's joyous blessings. When things go haywire one afternoon, it takes a crying

baby, an overflowing toilet, a harried police officer, five kittens, the new neighbours, and The Family Song to remind them of God's presence.



Death and Life in America:
Biblical Healing and BioMedicine, Herald Press, 2008.
Family physician Raymond
Downing offers a bold critique
of western medicine and sees
medical care as one of the fallen
"principalities and powers" in need
of redemption. But Downing's hope
lies beyond biomedicine—in biblical

healing, especially the healing miracles of Jesus. In conversation with the Bible, Ivan Illich, William Stringfellow, Susan Sontag, and others, Downing revisits how Westerners approach medicine. He sees suffering and healing as essentially spiritual experiences at the roots of life and death.
